I have also competed at the US Naval Academy on three occasions in precision air rifle and small bore. I competed in yearly District and State matches for nine consecutive years. Competed at Montgomery Bell Air Rifle Classic (Nashville, TN) national match and silver medaled in sporter air rifle. Competed in Junior Olympics (Anniston, AL and Camp Perry, OH) three times winning the NRA silver medal in prone at 2013 Junior Olympics in sporter air rifle; won NRA National Club Championship in 2013 and CMP National Club Championship in 2014. Competed in the NRA Prone Regional Matches for 2012 and 2013 receiving the Marksman first place medal in 2012; Competed at the NRA Spring Fling and won the 1st place Marksman in 2013. Overall, I have been awarded over 100, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place medals and trophies.

Future Plans: I am currently attending a 4-year university working toward a BSN in nursing; possibly an MSN.
