SHOOTING EXPERIENCE

I started my shooting career in 2016 with BB Gun, after about a year I won the Michigan State 4-H Tournament. Then in December of 2017, I began my Precision Rifle Career. In 2018 I competed in 35 matches including NRA Sectionals, CMP matches, USA Shooting Matches, NCAA Opens, and the NRA National Smallbore Championships. I have received my Master Classification cards for Precision Air Rifle Standing and for Smallbore Metric Position Outdoor, and have received my Expert Classification Card for Smallbore Metric Position Indoor. At the end of 2018 I competed in my state's Junior Olympic Tryouts, I shot the highest score in the state making me the 2019 State Junior Olympic Gold Medalist for Air Rifle, this allows me to go and compete in Colorado Springs in April at the Junior Olympics. I am also the 2019 Michigan Indoor 3-P Champion.

Besides shooting, I am an active member in my FFA Chapter. I am currently serving as the Chapter Reporter. Through FFA I compete in Public Speaking Events such as Prepared Public Speaking and Creed Speaking.
